**MEMORANDUM**

With reference to his/her application for admission to the Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology /M.Phil in Clinical Psychology/ M.Phil in Psychiatric Social Work course, the Candidate is hereby advised to be present at St. Joseph School, Kanke/CIP, Kanke, Ranchi on **16.02.2020 at 12.30 P.M.** for Entrance Examination, 2020. He/she should bring this Memo along with the Admit Card, failing which he/she will not be allowed to appear in the Entrance Examination. **Candidate should not bring any pen/pencil/eraser for the examination. Black Ball Point Pen will be provided by the Institute to mark the special OMR (Optical Mark Reader) answer sheet,** which will be evaluated through a Scanner and Computer. He / She cannot change the answer once marked by ball pen so he/she is advised to be careful while marking the answer. The venues for verification of admit cards and the written examination will be N N De Examination Centre at CIP and St. Joseph School, Kanke, Ranchi.

The list of candidates selected for Practical/interview on the basis of their performance in the written test will be displayed at Director's office on **17.02.2020**. The practical/interview will be carried out by duly constituted board in the following manner:

Ph.D. (Clinical Psychology)/ M.Phil in Clinical Psychology candidates : 18.02.2020 from 09:30 A.M.  
M. Phil (PSW) candidates : 19.02.2020 from 09:30 A.M.

In case of candidates scoring same marks in the written test and practical/interview for a particular course selection will be made on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the minimum qualifying examination, i.e., M.A./M.Sc.(Psychology) for M. Phil (Clinical Psychology), M. Phil (Clinical Psychology) for Ph.D.(Clinical Psychology), Master in Social Work for M. Phil (Psychiatric Social Work), respectively, failing which, candidate older in age will be selected.

**Examinee will not be allowed to enter the examination hall with any electronic communication gadgets viz. Mobile Phones, Calculator etc. and any pen/pencil/eraser. Examinee, who comes to the examination Centre, with such gadgets and stationery, he/she has to make his/her own arrangements for keeping these outside the examination Centre on his own risk and if any candidate is found in carrying any of these articles, he/she may be expelled from the examination. This should be strictly complied with.**

No TA/DA will be given for appearing at the written test/practical/interview. The candidates shall have to make their own arrangements for their stay in Ranchi. Selection of candidates is subject to the approval of the Selection Committee. Final approval in this regard will be given after their qualification etc. is approved by the Ranchi University.

The written test will be of objective type multiple choice questions consisting of 100 questions to be answered in 60 minutes.

A candidate in employment is required to bring with him/her a certificate from the employer stating that if selected, he/she will be deputed to the Institute for the entire duration of the course, or 'No Objection Certificate' as the case may be.

It is mandatory for all the students, who qualify in the written examination to attend the practical / interview; otherwise his/her candidature will be forfeited. The candidate has to produce all original certificates/testimonials at the time of interview. If any candidate is unable to produce the original certificates, he/she has to produce a certificate from the Head of the Institute/College/University stating that all original/following original certificates are submitted at that Institute/College/University etc. However, he /she must bring all the original certificates at the time of admission.

**15%, 7 ½% and 27% seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and OBC candidates respectively, subject to availability of such candidates. There shall also be 3% horizontal reservation for physically-handicapped persons {only for locomotor disabilities of lower limbs between 50% to 70% or as per the Govt. of India Rules in this regard} subject to availability of such candidates, if candidate is not available**

**between 50% to 70% then 40% to < 50% may be considered for Physically handicapped category. If suitable candidates are not available under the reserved categories, seats will be filled up by un-reserved category candidates. There is no reservation in Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology course.**

**Candidates who are seeking reservation benefit in the OBC category should submit a certificate as per DOPT O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res.), dated 13.09.2017.**

If the marks sheet is awarded according to Grade system the candidates must submit percentage of marks from their respective Universities to be eligible for the selection to the courses.

Central Institute of Psychiatry is located at Kanke, Ranchi. Ranchi is well connected by train, air and road. Kanke is about 8 K.M. from Ranchi city and about 15 K.M. from the Ranchi Railway Station. There is no hotel accommodation in Kanke, but accommodation is available in Ranchi city.

**Note: Candidates for M.Phil (PSW) / Ph.D.(Clinical Psychology) courses, whose results of M.A./ M.Sc./M.S.W./M.Phil.(Cl. Psychology/Medical & Social Psychology) final exams, are not declared and the mark sheets are not available, need not come for the written test. Reporting time for the examination is from 12.30 P.M. to 1.30 P.M. Anyone reporting late may not be allowed to sit for the written test.**
